You will also be able to participate in the organisation of the Centre, through our Annual General Meeting, which elects a Management Committee to decide the policy and direction of our work. Through this process:

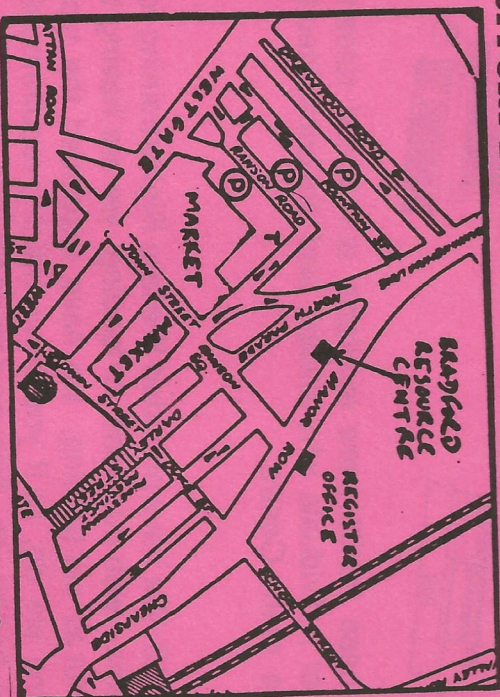
- * You decide what B.R.C.'s priorities are.

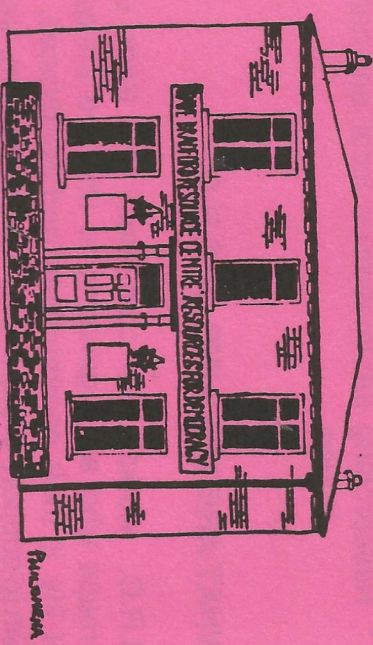

WHAT ARE THE AIMS OF B.R.C.?

B.R.C. works with community and trade union groups who are organising to improve the quality of life in their communities and workplaces. We aim to support groups who oppose racism, sexism and other forms of discrimination.

WHAT HAS B.R.C. GOT TO OFFER?

Community Library: we have a library of newspaper cuttings, pamphlets, campaign leaflets, journals, and books on a range of issues. These include: employment and welfare rights, black issues, women's issues, community issues, housing, health and economic issues.

Help and Research: B.R.C. workers can help to:

- * put you in touch with other groups
- * assist you to find information or undertake research
- * help you organise meetings or campaigns

HOW IS THE CENTRE RUN?

Day to day, the centre is run collectively by four part-time paid workers with volunteers and student placements.

Machines: There will be someone available to show you how to use the equipment at the Centre.
